

McGraw-Hill Education files for \$100m IPO

Educational content maker McGraw-Hill Education plans to go public. Best known as a publisher of textbooks and instructional materials, the company is now investing heavily in developing digital content and technology like its "Reading Wonders" and "Economics: Principles, Problems, and Policies" programs. It filed for an IPO that was valued at up to \$100 million, according to a form filed Friday with the Securities and Exchange

Commission. The \$100 million figure is an estimate used for the purpose of calculating a filing fee. The New York-based company says its programs are used by 250,000 higher education instructors and in 13,000 kindergarten to 12th-grade school districts. It also makes products for companies, academic institutions, libraries and hospitals. The company reported \$1.86 billion in revenue in 2014. (AP)

Toyota to invest \$50m

Toyota is investing \$50 million with Stanford University and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in hopes of gaining an edge in an accelerating race to phase out human drivers. The financial commitment announced Friday will be made over the next five years at joint research centers at the schools located in Silicon Valley and another technology hub in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Toyota has hired robotics expert Gill Pratt to oversee research aimed at developing artificial intelligence and other innovations that will enable future car models to navigate the roads without people doing all the steering and stopping. KUWAIT CITY, Sept 5: Under the terms of the debt restructuring agreements with the local banks, Noor Financial Investment Company has repaid the amount of KWD 5,500,000/- (Kuwait Dinar: Five Million Five Hundred Thousand only) to Kuwait Finance House as on 31st August 2015 being a partial repayment of the total debt amount. This repayment brings the total debt amount settled to the local banks as per our debt restructure agreements to KWD 53,364,500 (Kuwaiti Dinar: Fifty Three Million Three Hundred Sixty Four Thousand and Five Hundred only) which represents 34% till date.

Iraq plans new Eurobond

LONDON, Sept 5, (RTRS): Iraq plans to begin marketing a new Eurobond following the Labor Day holiday in the US, according to several sources, as the sovereign hopes to issue in the capital markets for the first time in nearly a decade. Representatives from the country are expected to meet investors across the U.S. and Europe ahead of the deal, which is likely to be unsecured. Citigroup, Deutsche Bank and JP Morgan will be the lead managers, the sources said. The US Labour Day holiday is on Sept 7. The sovereign is seeking to raise up to US\$6 billion through bond sales to relieve the pressure of low oil prices on state finances, though sources indicate this first deal will be much smaller. Last month Iraq received its first international credit rating after Fitch assigned a B- rating with a stable outlook, six notches below investment-grade. In its assessment Fitch cited political risks and insecurity that are among the highest faced by any sovereign rated by the agency. Iraq last issued an international bond in January 2006. That US\$2.66 billion 5.80 percent deal matures in January 2028. The note is trading at a cash price of 75.50, according to Thomson Reuters, to yield 10.23 percent.
